The message is:

- Move people urgently out of crowded immigration detention facilities
- Ensure a financial safety net and Medicare access for all in Australia, including people seeking asylum and refugees
- Prevent people losing legal status and access to support
- Move refugees and people seeking asylum from PNG and Nauru
- Ensure that refugees on temporary SHEV visas are not penalised in light of the COVID-19 pandemic
